Correction to Indoor Sports Spectator Restriction

March 6, 2021

Dear Mattituck Athletic Families,

Once again, our athletes and teams are practicing in preparation for their upcoming seasons.

As we begin our traditional Fall Sport Season, we will also begin to have spectators attend sporting events, although with some restrictions in place. **Section XI the governing body of Suffolk County Athletics recently announced:**

The Athletic Council, in conjunction with the Executive Board have approved the following resolution regarding spectators for the Fall season:

Indoor Sports: **No more than two spectators per athlete may be permitted, subject to facility capacities- Home spectators only**

Outdoor Sports: **No more than two spectators per athlete may be permitted, subject to facility capacities.**
**Schools may be more restrictive*

Mattituck will allow the following for the fall athletic season:

Indoor Sports: Only Two (2) guests **PER ATHLETE.**

This is due to the restrictive capacity in our gym to accommodate all of our players, our opponents and spectators while maintaining the physical distancing requirements.

Outdoor Sports: ONLY Two (2) guests **PER ATHLETE.**

The Mattituck School District understands how important family and community support is for our athletes and teams. We are asking for your patience and understanding as we begin to gradually return towards full spectator participation hopefully in the near future.

ADMISSION to Athletic Contests:

The following procedures will apply for Admission to Mattituck-Cutchogue School District Athletic Events:

- Each student athlete will receive two royal blue and yellow silicone bracelet imprinted with the words MATTITUCK ATHLETICS which will be given to two guests for admission into that athletes contest only
- All spectators will be required to show their bracelet to Security for admittance to the athletic event
- All spectators will have their temperature checked upon admittance to the athletic event by Security
- All spectators will always maintain mask face coverings

- All spectators will abide by social distancing requirements
- Spectators for Volleyball shall enter through the gym lobby
- Spectators for Soccer shall enter through the walk through on the West side of the High School next to the Booster Club Snack Shack
- Spectators for tennis shall remain in the South parking lot of the tennis court
- Cross Country Spectators shall abide by County Park requirements

Bracelet Significance:

The holder of this bracelet has permission to attend contests as permitted by the guidelines of the Host school and SECTION XI.

Upon entry the holder of this bracelet is confirming:

- 1. Has not knowingly been in contact with anyone having tested positive for COVID-19 in the last 14 days.*
- 2. Has not tested positive for COVID-19 in the past 14 days.*
- 3. Has not experienced COVID-19 symptoms in the past 14 days, including a fever greater than 100.0°F.*
- 4. Has not travelled international or from a State on the NYS Travel Advisory in the past 14 days.*

**** No school district will allow spectators from opposing districts admittance into indoor athletic contests
***Not all school districts will allow spectators from opposing districts admittance into outdoor athletic contest, a list will be provided to your child's coach ASAP*
